St Mary's

Work in St Mary's. Starting tomorrow, our Architect will be carrying out an inspection of nave roof timbers and our magnificent wooden angels to check for insect attack and rot. This requires the use of a cherry picker in the central aisle, so access to some areas will have to be closed whilst the work is carried out. We are also replacing the uplighters that illuminate the angels as some of these are defective and they are expensive to operate. The work will take approximately one week.
